

## Customer Reviews

School Zone Publishing Company began as The School Zone Learning Center in 1972. The Learning Center was a retail teachers supply outlet, specializing in sales to teachers, with two stores in Grand Rapids, Michigan. About 1974, schools instituted changes in educational methods that affected the home and schools. Changes included introducing new teaching methods in math and English and eliminating workbooks provided on a shared basis for home use. With these changes, parents experienced difficulty finding educational material for use at home. Local parents turned to the Learning Centers, requesting workbooks and other at-home teaching aids. In response, the Centers formulated six workbooks and printed 1,000 copies of each. The books sold out in six months. An expanded workbook series was developed and received equally enthusiastic acceptance. School Zone Publishing Company was incorporated in 1979. A new line of workbooks

had been written and illustrated by late 1979. In January 1980, the line was printed and School Zone began operations. Market response was extremely favorable. The product line has expanded yearly and currently includes over two hundred educational products.

I am a stay-at-home mom and I purchased this book for my 3 year old. What I enjoy most about this book is that it is simple to follow as an adult and gives clear and strait to the point directions for each activity. This is a great activity book for toddlers to learn how to use scissors properly and it is great for first time cutters. Also after cutting the shapes there are exercises that require them to match them up on the pages. One complaint about this book is that in the back of the book are where all the items you need to complete the exercises are located, you will have to cut up multiple exercises just to be able to do one. I wish that only one activity were on each page that way you do not have to practically cut up the entire book at once. Also another thing I did not like about this book is that it does not have the "tear-out" option for the pages, considering this is going to be a book that you would be require to remove the pages to complete the activity you would think they would at least provide "tear-out sheets". I had to remove the binding from this workbook and place each page in a document protector to make it simpler to use. The layout of this book could be improved. I feel that some parents enjoy this and some will not, but this book is very repetitious which in my opinion is a good thing because children do not learn in one sitting, things need to be repeated for the information to stick. Overall I think this is a great practice book for children and it is very colorful and gets their attention.

What I didn't like about this book, was that the parts to cut out, were placed in the back of the book. You have to basically cut apart a whole page, and leave in tact the page # at the bottom if you want to know where the cut outs belong. If I want my child to do only one page, I have to cut 3-4 pages worth of cut outs. I just feel the layout of this book could have been better 3/5 stars.

Good variety of activities - kids cut, glue the back and stick on based on the activity on the pages (fill in missing puzzle pieces, match rhyming words, match count of objects). I'm buying more for my other kids. At the right level for 4 year olds who know their basic numbers and understand rhymes / phonics. I feel that 3 year olds may not be ready for some of the better activities in this book. My toddlers cannot work on this independently however. I need to pick out (cut out) broad sections (from the last few pages) that are relevant to an activity before letting them at it. After that, they cut along dotted lines, glue the correct side, and paste the pieces (after I've explained what the page is

asking for). It's a good 5-10 minutes of independent activity before I need to guide them to the next one. Good price point too.

My son just started kindergarten and has a lot of difficulty using scissors. At first I try to teach and cost to endure, but after several activities of this wonderful book, he has done very well, I think even learned very quickly, because it is very colorful, and actually own activities of his age (4 years). Now it is actually what he prefer to do after he comes home from school. I am very happy that my son finds progress on this, on the other hand, I think that in the school is these same activities, including already made 1 or 2 of this book, but some lose interest, like my son because they are copies in black and white, and for children everything is more fun when there are colors. This is an excellent way to teach playing, cut and paste. the book brings only 32 pages I bought 2, but for the price is good.

Excellent book. I bought this when my son just turned 3 and it was too hard for him. He's 3.5 now and it's perfect! He loves cutting and pasting and there are some good learning activities too. He asks for this book every day. We've finished it now and I'm ordering a second one because he's so fond of it. I can see his scissor skills improve and I'm impressed with the other things he's learning (number recognition, rhyming, counting...) I think it would be too easy for a 5 year old, too hard for most 3 year olds but perfect for ages 3.5 - 4.

3 year old loves it. Some of concepts are a little more challenging for her, but the majority of the book she can do with mom and understand what she is doing. Its been great for beginning cutting and pasting. I like that it incorporates learning, counting, matching in with the activities.

Most of the cutting practice was just straight lines, but my granddaughter (age 3 1/2) really enjoyed the cutting, pasting, and matching. There were simple math activities, reading/phonics, and puzzles. I really wish there was a book 2 and book 3.
