

Since the early 1990s, Andrew has authored and updated more than 60 guidebooks, and supplied content for regional and national clients like Expedia and KLM. His photography has appeared in a wide variety of media, ranging from international golf magazines to a Ripley's Believe it or Not! Museum. Andrew and his wife Dianne also own Summerthought Publishing, a Canadian regional publisher of nonfiction books. He is a member of The Diners Club® World's 50 Best Restaurants Academy. Andrew has also spoken on travel

writing to a national audience and has contributed to a university-level travel writing textbook.

This was a thorough and easy to use guide, and I highly recommend it to those planning a trip to Nova Scotia. I enjoyed the conversational tone of the book. In future editions, though, I hope the author would beef up his recommendations for lodging and restaurants. The book is adequate in this regard now, but it would have been helpful if a few other options were listed. More restaurant recommendations would have been particularly nice, but I realize that restaurants have a way of coming and going, which would mean the guide's information runs the risk then of becoming dated.
