

Starred Review Wow. Just wow! This book is big in every way. Robertson, best known as a member of the Band, and his cowriters introduce the heavyweights of popular music to a new generation. Incredible thought has been put into this oversize offering, from selection of the artists to the eye-popping design and even to the quality of the paper. CDs of the artists' music are included, something books about musicians often miss. The book's art is hard to resist. Big, bold graphic portraits begin every section. A variety of illustrators have provided the pictures, and each one is so memorable you want to rip it out and frame it. (Don't do that.) Chuck Berry duckwalks on a checkerboard. Aretha sings her heart out at the piano. In a graphite image, more like a photo than a drawing, a young, beautiful Elvis, guitar in hand, eyes the reader. In a book so visually appealing, it's a treat that the words grab as much as the pictures. Though each artist gets just a two-page spread, there's such well-chosen personal and professional information, young people will come away with an understanding of each person's evolution. All of the material feels fresh, and with back matter aplenty, there are lots of ways that this could be used in schools—or kids could just kick back, read, and listen. Grades 6-12. --Ilene Cooper

Regardless of age, this book would have been great for just the artists' profiles (written so that children might be introduced to these great artists). Each artist has a full-page portrait, original art done by remarkable artists and suitable for framing (I can imagine postcards and posters to accompany -- I'd purchase them.) The book is large-format and the printing quality is first-rate. Eye-popping. The fact that you also get two CDs with essential cuts from each artist makes this the book of the year -- perhaps the book of the decade. The CDs are worth the purchase price alone. I hope a volume 2 is in the works!

Bought this book as a way to teach my kids about modern music. We are currently reading a chapter or two a night (2 pages) with a 6 year old girl and 4 year old boy. Some of it is a little (just a little) over their heads, but overall they are gaining a huge appreciation of lots of different types of music. They now ask for Bob Marley in the car and Chuck Berry to dance to at home. They want to know how the different styles of music fit together and what genres were first, who influenced who, etc. Overall we are very happy with the book. I have always loved The Band and you can tell Robbie Robertson is not only a life long student of music, but also a huge fan of the musicians he writes about (sometimes a little over the top). The song for each chapter is a nice touch as well. However, I have found using Spotify or YouTube to play the suggested song is easier since it is right on my iPhone and often the kids want to hear more examples of the artist we are reading about (more than one song worth). Great time of year to pick this up - covers all genres and varieties of 20th century music and would do well under the tree.

I have finally found a way to introduce a life long love of music to my children and other children in my life. I love all kinds of music, but I've been deliberating on how to give my kids a fun point of reference on the roots of it all - after literally years of searching - here it is! This is the perfect Holiday gift as well. It's just a beautiful and poetic presentation with anecdotes that I've never heard before. I hope there will be more volumes to follow!!

This book is full of colorful graphics, but there's almost no content. If you want to find out any significant information about any of these musicians, this is NOT the book for that. It's little more than an illustrated list. Very disappointed. Returned the book.

We forget how much of American Music is related, like a wonderful family tree. Tin Pan Alley meets Rock & roll. Gospel meets R & B, Dixieland leads to Jazz leads to Sinatra and Ella. The Band & Robbie Robertson captured that energy and now he becomes the history teacher & damn good one! It's also obvious that Robbie the 'dad' has done a great job of passing on the legacy and the love of America's music to his son. This was a Christmas gift for my grandsons, both musicians. I hope this causes them to look behind the curtain and listen to music and artists that they hadn't heard before this book/album.

This book is accompanied by CD's - I heard it described on public radio as a gift for ages 9-12, but

every adult who has seen it has wanted one, and it's a great gift for families. It tells of each artist's talents, successes and, in some cases, results or poor choices too, in a manner sensitive to all ages. The art work is also magnificent, and the taste of each one's music on the CD's is a wonderful sampling, and can be shared by multiple generations.
