

The Lawless series really makes you think about what might be. Whether or not such a scenario, as depicted in this story, might ever happen is not the point but rather the underlying issues of how we might respond. Regardless of what might be the story is well written and interesting.

Absolutely love her books, her characters and storyline just keep you entranced.

I liked The Fringe series okay, but the Lawless Saga is just plain dumb. I read about seventy-five books a year on average, and I like the post-apocalypse genre fairly well, but this one is low on the list. I'm being generous by giving it three stars, because frankly it's really a two. I think I'm second-guessing myself because of the number of five-star reviews, which are inexplicable to me. The characters are unrealistic and silly, to the point where I had trouble finishing the third book in the series. Every few pages someone is having an emotional meltdown and taking an absurd course of action that no real person would ever take, recovering miraculously from life-threatening injuries in a matter of hours, or inflicting wanton cruelty upon someone for sheer enjoyment even when it's completely counterproductive for all concerned. She tries to convey to us that the characters are sophisticated and thoughtful, and yet those characters basically just fist-fight and act like idiots in almost all circumstances. They're supposedly savvy, and yet they're prone to forgetting key pieces of information that they've already learned the hard way, and that the reader is aware of, and they find themselves in exactly the same predictable situation all over again, etc. If you've run out of other titles, by all means go for it; there are some things that are interesting about it.

This series is getting better and better! I love Tarah Benner's easy, clear and informative writing style. The plot has so much action...which this author does so well..it's very hard to put the book down. She has done her research into global warming and the devastating affects on our ecosystem and written a very real picture of what our country would become as our civilization takes a dive...survival is key, and the corporations have it. The chemistry of the main characters is solid as they are now separated, not knowing if either is alive, captured or what! Who do you trust when you're escaped convicts just learning what has happened on the outside? What about your fellow escapees? What has happened to our world...is there still law? I cannot say enough about the quality of this series, and, as I mentioned, it is just getting better! I may have received an ARC, but I didn't have to be asked to give my honest opinion. Read it!!! It is a poignant story of a very real possibility in our near future.

Tarah does not disappoint with Ruthless, the third installment in the Lawless series. It is obvious that Tarah does her research and then applies that to her amazing world building and captivating characters. She creates each character and their relationships with care and makes you root for

them to succeed. In this book, we follow Lark, Soren, Bernie, Simjay, Axel, Portia and of course Denali through their continued escape from San Judas. They have been separated again and each group does everything they can to reach and help the others. I love all of Tarah's books and encourage you to read her other series, including The Defectors Trilogy, The Fringe series and her standalone, Bound in Blood.

This book is a great addition to this series. It's very well done, with great action scenes, and the characters are developed enough that you feel like you know them. It was difficult to put down. Well worth your time to read. I would highly recommend reading both this series and the recon series. Tarah has a knack for pulling you into her stories and you can't put them down once you start reading. I can't wait for the next book.
