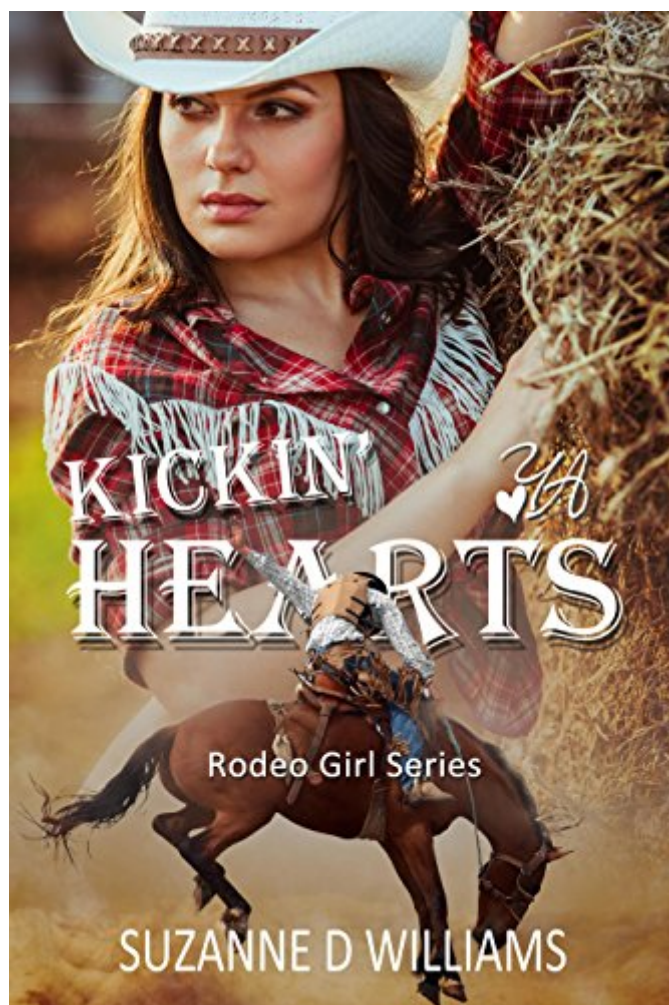


The book was found

Halston Kane feels left out as the middle child; and when his mother dies, things go from bad to worse. He wants to be good at something, and usually that's bronc riding, but even his rodeoing has taken a nosedive. He's always admired Destiny Mullens, but she doesn't have the best reputation and is with someone else. When Destiny needs help, Halston is not sure what to do. He can barely help himself, so can he be there for someone who needs him? This story had a good start, but nothing was well-developed. Destiny said she wanted to change, but I saw little changes besides dumping her old boyfriend. The Kane family were supposed to be Christians, but no one ever prayed. Halston said he planned to keep himself sexually pure, but I questioned what was happening at the end. And speaking of the ending, I hated it. Although it hinted at a happy ending, it did not leave me satisfied, because I'm guessing the author wants me to buy the next book. It had several minor mistakes, like "automatic" for "automatically" and "started" for "startled" and used the "b" word for a boy born out of wedlock twice. It had potential and could have been good, but it wasn't. It felt underdeveloped, scattered, and incomplete.

It never got easier to bronc ride, that's why Halston loved it. He loved the look of Destiny, but way off limits, to him, she belonged to Wilson. Destiny, was tired of building Wilson ego up, and realizing what she had become, nothing. He was persistent, and wouldn't give her up. The wisdom of his dad, telling Halston, to let go of the envy of what Wilson has, and the wins. Whose knocking at the door, and with that things change. Another winner from Suzanne, a good plot, characters, and about lessons in life.

Although a clean read it pushes the limits some for example, Destiny shows up wearing a see through nightgown. I got this as a recommendation from a Christian fiction site but it was not. There was the perfect opportunity to present how to become a believer but it story went a different direction. The plot was good however it was not developed enough to be believable. The characters were only partial developed but is typical for a short book.
