

This book shows how faith in God gives hope in the worst situations. In spite of growing up in an atheistic home, Anita believed in Jesus and trusted His sacrifice for her sins. She knew He was with her in every situation. She was not alone. It was very encouraging, because we may be facing the same situation here in the USA. We can still react with love, to people who treat us unfairly, because God loves us. Even with the threat of imprisonment facing them, believers in Christ and pastors helped the Jewish people like Anita, & her mother & sister, who had no way to provide for themselves or their families. Many Christians were executed or taken to the death camps where they were starved and worked to death. Books like this show the progression of a leader or government making a group of people less than human. Changes are made little by little, until before you know it, you have no freedom or rights. Children & teens were not allowed to attend certain schools, until finally they were not allowed to attend school at all. Adults were not allowed to own businesses or work. They were forced to accept government assistance to eat & feed their families, and then forced to work 10-hr days, 7 days a week in factories supporting the war. It happened little by little, until it was too late for the German people to do anything about it.

So sad on what Hitler did to so many Jews and so many people that helped them. God was with so many as long as they kept their faith in Him. As hard as this is to do sometimes God will protect you. Anita found this how wonderful God really is and how He protected His children. God's Word will never leave us it will protect, heal, and comfort us. Anita's faith was strong because she believed and stepped out in faith that God was and always will be with her.
