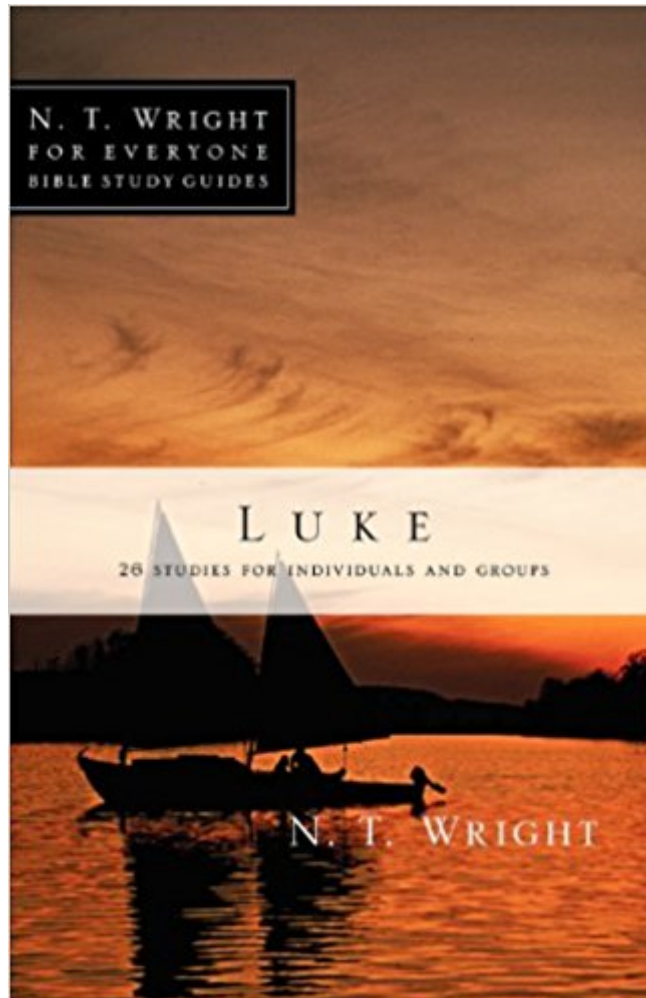




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Luke (N.T. Wright For Everyone Bible Study Guides)

A prolific writer of both scholarly and popular books, N. T. Wright has written over thirty books, including *Simply Christian*, *The Original Jesus*, *What Saint Paul Really Said*, *The Challenge of Jesus*, *The Meaning of Jesus*, *Jesus and the Victory of God* and the magisterial *Paul and the Faithfulness of God*. His N. T. Wright For Everyone Series includes commentaries covering the entire New Testament. Formerly bishop of Durham in England, Wright is research professor of New Testament and early Christianity at the University of St Andrews in Scotland. He was formerly canon theologian of Westminster Abbey and dean of Lichfield Cathedral. He also taught New Testament studies for twenty years at Cambridge, McGill and Oxford Universities. He has been a visiting

professor at Harvard Divinity School, Hebrew University in Jerusalem, Gregorian University in Rome and many other institutions around the world. In addition to his many books, Wright reaches a broad audience through his frequent media appearances. A sought-after commentator, Wright writes frequently for newspapers in England, including the Times, the Independent and the Guardian. He has been interviewed numerous times by radio and television broadcasters on both sides of the Atlantic, including ABC, NBC, CNN, PBS and NPR. Patty Pell (M.A., Old Testament Studies, Denver Seminary) is a staff worker with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship on the campus of the University of Northern Colorado and at Christ Community Church in Greeley, Colorado. She is the author of Esther and Hospitality in the LifeGuide® Bible Study series and a coauthor of Small Group Leaders' Handbook.

I've used the "For Everyone" series of commentaries several times, so when we were looking for a new small group curriculum this great bible study by Wright was an automatic contender. We've been using it for 8 weeks now and our participants are big fans. Wright balances his comments with discussion-inducing questions that get our groups talking. There is also a great leader's guide at the back of the book that can help any volunteer become a top-notch small group leader. While it is really meant for group work, this could also make for a good personal study guide along with the corresponding New Testament for Everyone commentary.

A great study guide to learn the life of Jesus in Luke's perspective. We use it for our bible study group but I personally think it is great for individual study as well.

Kinda simplistic and the some questions are super-easy while others bewilder, making you wonder what exactly is being sought by author...or perhaps he doesn't write the questions. This is not N.T. Wright's commentary on Luke, but a Bible study for a group who have not had much training in Bible content or theology. That said, this is a great study. Highly recommend it for the appropriate group.
