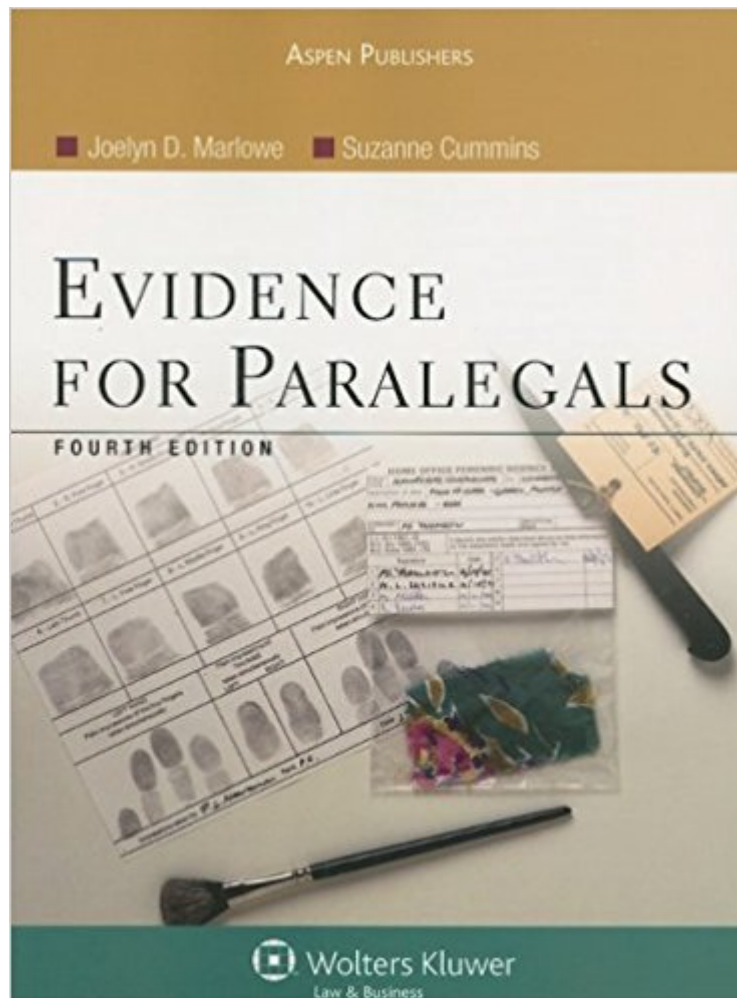




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Evidence For Paralegals

It does seem to have a few places where it is either inaccurate or just not written clearly, but overall, this is one of the better texts I have had to purchase. I like the organize information provided in the book, but I found some misspelled words. The misspelling caused some confusion as to what the author was try to say, but eventually I began to get caught up to it and figured out.
