Great second book in this new Kurtherian offshoot. The setting of this offshoot feels more closely aligned to the Original BA Kurtherian Gambit series of books that started this complex universe, which has the potential for many offshoots. While I may not like some of the characters as much as those in the original Kurtherian series, the characters are complex and well developed. The storyline

is interesting and exciting. The author's writing skills are very good and help convey the storyline at a fast pace without being muddled with any sidebars or tangential explanations. The book does at the end leave a lot of loose ends following the foiling of the attempt to poison the water supply. It is going to be hard to wait for the third book in this series.

Ell Leigh Clarke's second contribution to the universe of Michael Anderle's Kurtherian Gambit (and 2nd book) is definitely 2 thumbs up. Our heroine, Molly's genius make her life challenging at times, but the reader can't help being firmly in her corner as she explores the perils of living and working in a dangerous new business venture and the myriad of people problems and plain physical hazards that accompany same. We see Molly's crew (as well as mission) begin expansion, as well as getting a surprising and delicious peek back into BA's 'verse. I am eagerly anticipating the next installment in the Age of Expansion, as I can't wait to see where Molly's and her crew go from this point.

What makes this a five-star book, rather than anything less, is simply Molly. The author manages to transcend a rather routine thriller which is about 90% of this book with a brilliant portrayal of Molly. It makes the whole book work on another level all together. So this was a good building block in whatever it is that Molly and her team are trying to accomplish in their world building, and more importantly the first real tie to Molly and the Kurtherian Federation. So two books in, good progress, characters continue to be developed, new characters are being added, still need more of Oz's character in my opinion; but all in all this series is definitively taking on a life of its own.

Molly is back, kicking ass by using her greatest strength- her brain! While this entry in the series feels like it's more about team building than the individuals, it really allows us to see Molly as the savant she is. So here I am, one day after this book combed out, and I am already waiting for book 3. The combination of Ells writing and MAs guidance is absolutley intoxicating. I live the characters, and Ell writes differently enough from the other Kurtherian authors that the characters don't feel like rehashed paper dolls and over used archetypes, but as actual people.
