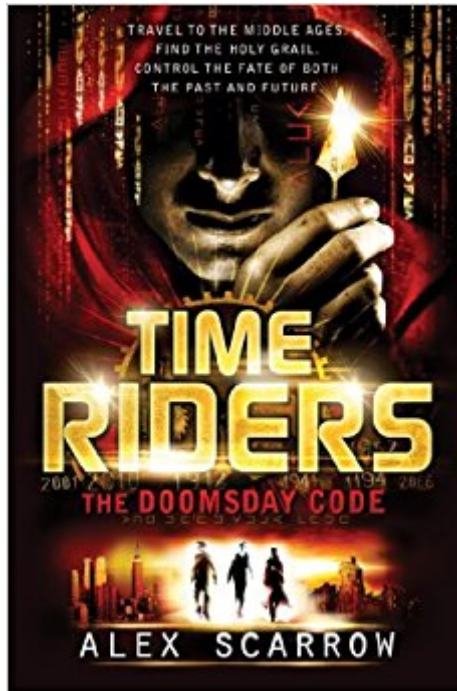




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TimeRiders: The Doomsday Code

9. 4th book The Eternal War

This is not a suggested reading order just my personal preference of the books in the storyline. I really liked 4 of the first five books because of the combination of historical locations and of course the time travel. Book 4 got the lowest rating because of what I considered a poor representation of my favorite President. The author is British so that might explain it. After book five I wasn't as engaged because for the next two books the characters aren't really on a mission anymore. I felt the new "home base" was a ridiculous location both physically and time wise. The last two books are really just about wrapping up the storyline and like I said originally they aren't bad but it's obvious that the adventures are over. I wasn't that thrilled with the ending. It's not horrible but I think the characters deserved more than they were given. I know this sounds cryptic and I should have posted this under The Infinity Cage but The Doomsday Code is my favorite book in the series. I want to encourage everyone who reads this to read them all then try to rate their favorites too.

Confusing at first, but the story soon becomes a nail biting adventure.
