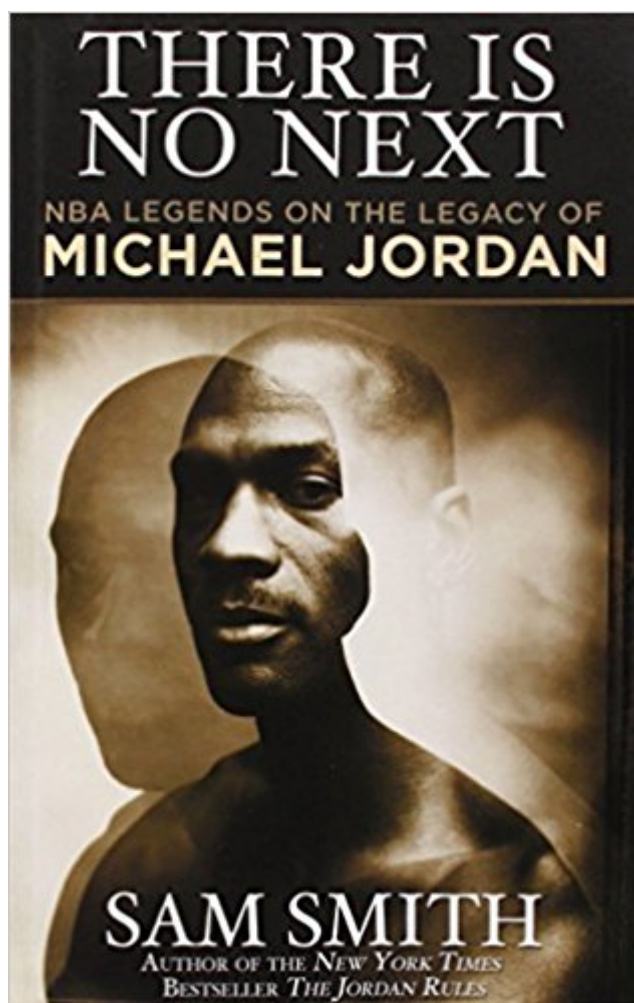


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There Is No Next: NBA Legends On The Legacy Of Michael Jordan

Sam Smith has been covering the Chicago Bulls and the NBA for more than three decades, as reporter and columnist for The Chicago Tribune for 28 years, and currently for Bulls.com. Recipient of the prestigious Curt Gowdy Media Award from the NBA Hall of Fame, he also received the Professional Basketball Writers Association Lifetime Achievement award in 2011. He is the author of the classic bestselling book *The Jordan Rules*, for which he had unparalleled access to Michael Jordan and 1991-92 Chicago Bulls. He has written extensively for media outlets around the world, including ESPN.com, ESPN magazine, NBC Sports, Basketball Digest, The Sporting News, and for major publications in Japan and China.

I've read a couple of other books on MJ but Sam did a fabulous job on this one. A lot of in depth interviews from his peers, opponents, coaches, and other people who have insights on him. Sam also gave great insights on MJ's teammates and what was happening behind the scenes during his first 3 championships and during his second 3 championships after his 1.5 year hiatus. Very entertaining, it made me want to keep coming back to it every chance I got until I finished it. Get it!

I enjoyed this account of Micheal Jordan's affect on the NBA during his career. The insight from Sam's perspective as a sports writer is awesome as well as the interviews from the NBA players that played against him.

This was a good book. I don't think it was as good as *The Jordan Rules* by Sam Smith, but definitely worth the money if you're a fan of Michael Jordan. What I liked most about it was reading all the comments about Jordan by his peers - Scottie Pippen, Magic Johnson, Steve Kerr, Grant Hill, etc. They played with MJ on a regular basis but were still in awe of him because he was THAT good.
