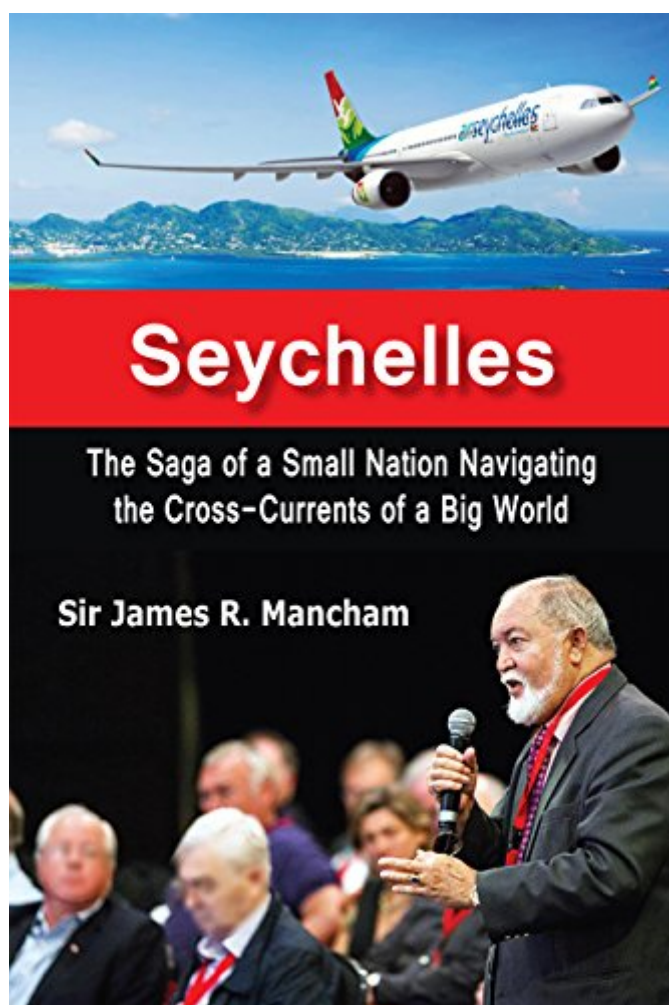


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Seychelles: The Saga Of A Small Nation Navigating The Cross-Currents Of A Big World
