

Awesome coverage of the early years of barber shops in America. The photos are great. The advertisements of barber chairs, poles, razors, etc are all here. Tons of interesting characters and stories are contained in this work.

The book shares a very interesting reminder of the past and the history of barbing during the 19th & 20th centuries. It explains why barber poles exist, why there were shaving mugs, and why those customs allowed gentlemen of those times to relax and enjoy their shave, their haircut, and their pampering. How many guys have someone else shave their faces for them now? How many wrap their faces in warmed towels to loosen things up? Why have our business people -- and other adult males -- given up the luxury of old time barber shop pampering.
