

For nearly 20 years, Bill Murphy has been a leader in North America helping farmers to use the pasture resource to its fullest potential in cutting production costs. As many successful pasture-based farmers know, there is no cheaper way to feed livestock than on pasture and this book explains how to do it!

Lots of great information in this book, very practical and applicable for people who raise cows, sheep or goats. You can skim some of the statistical details and just get to the practical parts if you just want to know what it means for your farm on a day to day basis: how to set up pasture rotation, when to move animals on and off a certain pasture, etc. However, I'm not sure how applicable it is for people with pastures in California because when it stops raining here in April, the grass dries up almost immediately. In areas where it rains periodically all summer, this book would be super useful.

A very complete discussion of intensive pasture management. Murphy's explanation is very good, however, this method of farming is not simple, and requires the farmer to make weekly analysis and planning adjustments. It is a method that requires both the farmer's hands and his mind. Not for the absentee or part time farmer.

I'm reading this book for the third time - there's just too much info to digest in one reading. We are just starting with cattle and are using this book as our bible. It not only explains the many advantages of raising animals using management intensive grazing (more profit, environmentally friendly, humane, better nutrition, ease of animal handling), it goes into great detail on HOW to do it. My husband used the chapter on fencing to select products that have received many positive comments from visitors to the farm. I especially enjoyed reading about pasture plant diversity and how cattle "harvest" it. Our cattle look (and taste) great, much to the shock of long-time cattle farmers in our community who are surprised that two greenhorns like us can do so well. We attribute our success to this book and highly recommend it.
