

This book is best for its description of private schools. It doesn't have much information about the selective public schools.

Solid guide to Manhattan schools!

Bought this to research selective public schools, as referred to in the title of this book. Ten thousand students attend these exceptional schools. These authors were so interested in this population that they devoted six paragraphs to their schools; and that was five schools out of MANY schools. I'd call that really mis-titling a book, and I would call that self-serving and unethical.

This book gives you more information about each individual private school in NYC than any other resource you can buy. I can't imagine looking for a private school in Manhattan without having this wonderful guide.

This guide isn't perfect (could be more comprehensive), but it's the best available. While there are many college guidebooks available, unfortunately there are only a few books about NYC private schools. And despite the different titles, these books often contain content written by the schools themselves. Refreshingly, Goldman and Hausman's book is different because it is written by two private school moms. Seeking input from private school parents and students, the two authors offer more inclusive profiles than are available elsewhere. As a local educational consultant, I often recommend this book to my families as a good starting point for their research. Families will learn about the admissions process and about the individual schools.
