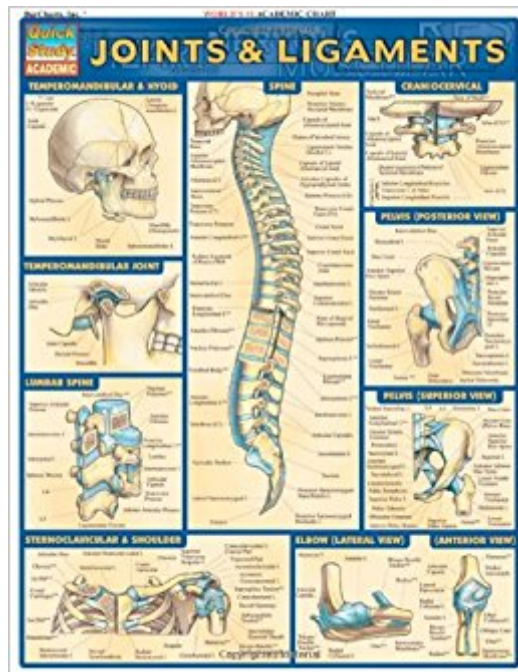

This is an excellent little chart, laminated and punched to fit in a ring binder notebook. It would be great at 3'x4', but that's not what I ordered. Those who have trouble with small type might want to keep looking, literally. Arrived a day early, but, a note to the manufacturers: Package this thing properly. If it wasn't stiff laminated plastic, I very much doubt it would have gotten here intact. Bubble envelopes aint gonna get it.

I am a huge fan of the BarCharts and have many. This one is nicely laminated, fits well in a binder or just by itself. They are great for a quick reference, supplementing your textbooks, or having in your workplace for a quick look. I do realize that in a world of Google some might think these obsolete. For me nothing can beat something tangible. I have not been disappointed with any of the BarCharts that I have purchased.

I have a lot of problems with ligaments so wanted to see just what was going on in my body. This chart helps me understand what is happening and how the doctor and physical therapists are helping fix the problem.
