

The beginning of the book offers some good information, although it's a bit dated at this point since the Affordable Care Act has become more established. The other chapters that discuss specific professions can all be found - nearly verbatim if not identical - on the online Bureau of Labor Statistics webpage. Not all healthcare professions are included in this book, which of course is to be expected, but some are glaringly absent such as the CAM professions (e.g. chiropractic, acupuncture, etc.). An updated edition of this book might be more useful, especially considering its

hefty current price of \$85.
