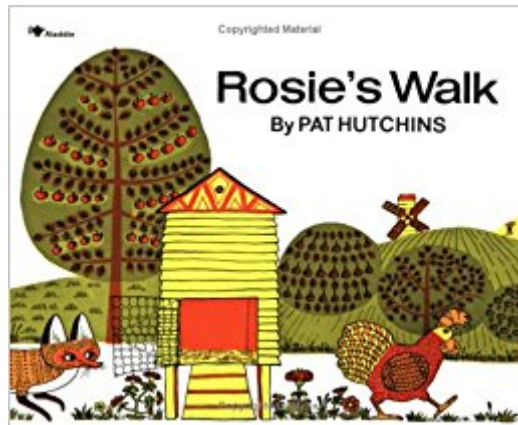




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Rosie's Walk

This is a great book that every child should have the opportunity to hear and read. Younger children will need someone older to read it and explain the plot, but then enjoying books with a loving adult who takes the time to read to them is what forms the love of reading anyway so that's ok. The illustrations are simple, and the predictable text that goes along with the illustrations makes it a good book for emerging readers to enjoy. It also teaches some positional vocabulary and is entertaining .

The story is difficult for a nearly 2-year-old to follow, particularly because of the illustrations. Figure-ground distinctions lack clarity; colors and patterns blend together too much. Not a very engaging story, although I know it's considered a classic tale. Probably better for a 5+-year-old, in understanding the reason for the fox's stalking of the hen and Rosie's obliviousness to the pursuit.

The way and skill of the graphical illustration is so fine to tell the lovely story of Rosie walking and his secret companion, the fox, following her. Not many words are needed to tell how Rosie is lucky and very sure of her pathway while walking. Pictures tell more than thousands of words! The one is not so lucky, the fox, who is collecting all the harm after Rosie walking. Poor, poor him! Children and their parents can have many wonderful conversations by looking and reading together this lovely book. The graphical illustration is like a simple very delicious, sweet, tasty, colourful "caramel".

Love this book! Has great pictures. Lots of spatial concepts to explore as the hen goes for her walk and the fox creeps up behind her. Simple story that is easy to elaborate on as a reader, or for a little to describe/"read." Mine want to read this book every night!

The pictures tell the clever story of a hen taking a walk while seemingly unaware she is being stalked by a fox. The fox doesn't have a chance, though, because for every move he makes, there is a consequence that makes youngsters giggle. The simple text helps children learn prepositions (over, under, across, through, etc.).

We raise chickens and this was my son's favorite book when he was little. The drawings are perfect little vintage pieces. The story teaches prepositions and captures the personality of chickens in a priceless manner. We always have at least one hen named Rosie in our flock.

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
