The Times is a British daily national newspaper, first published in London in 1785. A daily cryptic crossword is published in the main newspaper, and the Mind Games section in the Times2 supplement contains sudoku, Killer Sudoku, KenKen, word polygon puzzles, and a quick crossword.

If you like Crosswords chances are you will like Code Words too. Book starts with easy puzzles and slowly progresses in difficulty. Use a pencil because these puzzles will definitely challenge you. Boy oh boy - am I increasing my vocabulary. I've never heard of some of the words for the more difficult puzzles. I keep my dictionary and/or tablet close when working these out. Wish the puzzles were larger in size or came in a Large Print version.

If you've never done this type of word puzzle before, think of a crossword puzzle that lets you put letters in when you don't have a clue about the word. It's different, but if you love word puzzles, you'll like this type of puzzle as well! I've ordered 4 of these type books so far, and I'll get more....

These books are nice because they are an alternative to crosswords that I always struggle with. I do all of the top pages then go back and tear them out to do the other side so I don't have to struggle with the binding.

I am a BIG fan of code words. These can't be found in stores every where. Not quite crossword, not quite sudoku. A game in it's own league! match each letter to the corresponding number from 1-26. Each puzzle has a different number.

Wife loves these. What more can I say but we will buy more of these and we recommend this to you.
