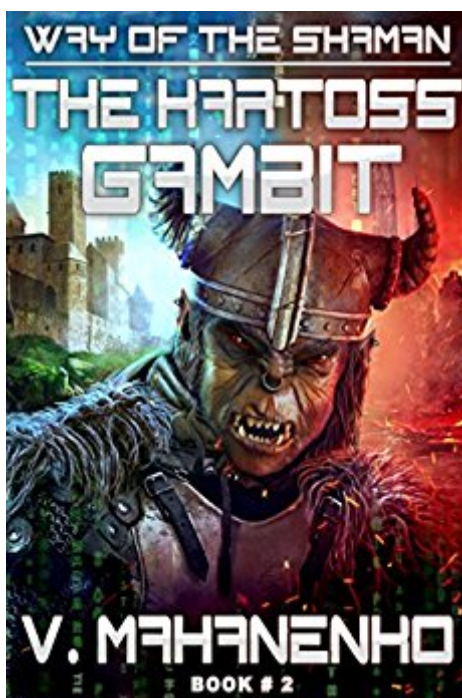


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The Kartoss Gambit (The Way Of The Shaman: Book #2) LitRPG Series

In this sequel to "Survival Quest (The Way of the Shaman: Book #1)," our main character continues his journey as a prisoner in the virtual world of Barliona. He managed to get out of the mines in record time and is on parole in the main game world. He is sent to a small village at the edge of the kingdom, marked as a convict, and cannot spend more than 48 hours at a time away from it. And

the nearest town is 48 hours away by cart...This book really shines. The gaming aspects of Barliona are still present in this book. Indeed, the MMO side of things gains greater depth with the introduction of clans, more players, and the world as a whole. He is still a low-level player, but through clever use of his abilities, manages to get the attention of some movers and shakers in the game (not that this is necessarily a good thing!). Very naturally, the MC seems to be entangled in some major events that affect Barliona. Additionally, his journey as a Shaman comes into greater focus. The potential of the class comes out more as he is able to practice his class skills. With access to the forums and wiki, the MC's personal journey as a shaman also becomes more pronounced. Will he forge his own path, or seek out tips & shortcuts from the forums? All in all, a great book. If you liked Mahanenko's first book, "Survival Quest," this one is even better! And if you like LitRPG, this is at the top of my list so far. 5 stars!

This book was a solid continuation of the series. I particularly enjoy that the author manages to make the character's class and powers unique and interesting without making it feel as if he was handed god-like abilities for no reason at all. (I find this to be a rarity in this genre, sadly.) The powers are investigated and mostly earned. I thought the character had a bit too much unprompted authority in the eyes of his peers during the end stages of the book, but it didn't come off too badly. The world is interesting, the plot continues to be interesting, and the writing isn't bad. Overall I'd recommend this book to just about anyone interested in a fun and stress free read. I could hardly put it down once I'd started.

This is an outstanding sequel. I was not dissappointed at any of the plot moves - on the contrary, some of the new directions for the work were unexpected and considerably expanded the scope, which a sequel in an extended series should always try to do. Really impressive, engaging work - some of the best of the litRPG genre in general that I have read.

The series had a somewhat improbable opening, though it did set the stage for the first and now the second book. The author appears to concentrate on what he does fairly well -- the gaming and internal dialog aspects. Conversations with other characters are often "flat", and characters other than the main character are generally 2 dimensional. It's probably a good thing that the author has avoided "sex scenes"...The book's ending felt a bit disorganized -- it can either ruin the next book and series, or help build the series plot. I look forward to seeing which course the author's next book takes...
