

While a fictional book Pickett skillfully addresses a very "real" issue that is all too familiar to many young adults today. She carries this fast moving story smoothly to the end and delivers an ending that does not disappoint. My simple review cannot do this book justice that's why I'm a reader and not a writer! CAUTION: Do not start this book if you have other things to do, because you will NOT put it down.

I am disturbed by this book. Yes, it is well written, BUT...the way the situation is handled is disturbing...SPOILERS...The girl, Willow is keeping a secret that makes her life miserable. How? She is physically abused by her stepfather (who knows her secret), with a mother that does NOTHING to help her - and, a boyfriend (who also knows her secret) and decides to torment her,

because, why? And, this is where my first problem with this book comes. Why is her boyfriend tormenting her? He doesn't seem to really want anything from her really...It just seems evil for the sake of drama - I could understand if he wanted something from her, like sex or whatever - but his life just goes on, and once in a while he tells her she needs to stay as his girlfriend...?!!!? Three other people in her life don't make sense either - two best friends -a girl and a guy - and a hot new love interest. All these three people are aware that she is abused and DO NOTHING ABOUT IT! Seriously! She tells them to lay off, and THEY DO! Not only that, but this girl is walking around joking and acting every day as if nothing happens to her! Really! Not only that, but there are many situations happening in school (public) where her boyfriend drags her/pushes her to her desk and once twists her finger while they all watch and do nothing about it.
