

Good book, but the Kindle version displays two pages at once and can't zoom in, making the text pretty small to read. You can zoom in on the text, just not on the pictures. Make sure you preview a sample before you buy it.

The book was cute and got across the message of saving to my kids, but the two-pages-per-screen was annoying! The pictures were so small, even with the laptop instead of my ipad, that the kids became frustrated. I didn't like the feature that let you hover over lines of text to enlarge them because it was not user friendly - a little buggy on both the ipad and the laptop. If I need this book again I will borrow it from the library.
